NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-3 and 42-35-9, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) is conducting a hearing on **Monday, June 3, 2024 at 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, R.I. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and from time to time as required. The hearing will be streamed live at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

At this hearing, the Commission will examine a Petition submitted by The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (RI Energy) for Acceleration of a System Modification Due to Distributed Generation Projects. The Petition was filed pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.3-4.1 entitled Interconnection Standards (Interconnection Statute) and Section 5.4 of RIPUC No. 2258 entitled The Narragansett Electric Company Standards for Connecting Distributed Generation (Interconnection Tariff). The interconnection request that is the subject of the Petition for the Tiverton Projects was made by Green Development, LLC in connection with a 11,791 kW photovoltaic system located at 390 Brayton Road, Tiverton, R.I. Rhode Island Energy seeks certain findings from the Commission related to the acceleration of the System Improvements stemming from the Tiverton Projects and the applicability of the Interconnection Statute and the Company's Interconnection Tariff.
