Minutes of Open Meeting Held on March 2, 2022

An Open Meeting of the Public Utilities Commission (Commission or PUC) was held Wednesday, March 2, 2022, at 10:15 A.M. in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island to discuss, deliberate, and/or vote on the following dockets.

In attendance: Chairman Ronald Gerwatowski, Commissioner Abigail Anthony, Commissioner John Revens, Cynthia Wilson Frias, Emma Rodvien and Luly Massaro.

I. Chairman Gerwatowski called the Open Meeting to order at 10:15 A.M. A quorum was present

II. **Docket No. 5073 – Retail Energy Supply Association (RESA) and The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid** – This docket relates to the implementation of a Purchase of Receivables Program (POR). The Commission approved the POR and Narragansett Electric’s Terms and Conditions. At this meeting, the Commission considered Narragansett Electric’s calculation of the Standard Complete Billing Percentages and the percentage applied to existing receivables to be purchased, filed with the Commission January 7, 2022. The Division and intervenors support approval. After review, Chairman Gerwatowski moved to approve Narragansett Electric’s compliance filing for effect April 1, 2022. Commissioner Revens seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

III. **Renewable Energy Resource Eligibility Applications** – The Commission reviewed the applications submitted in the following dockets. PUC consultant recommended full approval of the applications. Chairman Gerwatowski moved to accept PUC consultant recommendations to approve the applications listed below. Commissioner Anthony seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

Docket No. 5214 – Coventry Carr's, LLC application for eligibility of the Coventry Carr’s LLC generation unit, a 0.750 MW AC (0.998 MW DC) solar facility located in Coventry, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

Docket No. 5213 – GD Richmond West Shannock I, LLC application for eligibility of the GD Richmond West Shannock I, LLC generation unit, a 0.249 MW AC (0.250 MW DC) solar facility located in Richmond, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

IV. **Approval of Minutes of Open Meetings**
Commissioner Anthony moved to approve the Minutes of Open Meeting on January 25, 2022 and Commissioner Revens seconded the motion. The motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

Commissioner Revens moved to approve the Minutes of Open Meeting on January 28, 2022 and Commissioner Anthony seconded the motion. The motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

Commissioner Anthony moved to approve the Minutes of Open Meeting held on February 11, 2022 and Commissioner Revens seconded the motion. The motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
