NOTICE OF PARTICIPATION/INTERVENTION

The Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has opened a new docket to review misconduct or potential fraud by The Narragansett Electric Company relating to the manipulation of the reporting of invoices affecting the calculation of past energy efficiency shareholder incentives.
