In preparing the response to Division 2-2, the Company determined that it inadvertently used an incorrect percentage when calculating the Return & Income Taxes as shown on Page 8 of the Company's May 9, 2022 Electric Earnings Report and in Attachment Division 1-5, which amount is shown on Attachment Division 2-2, Page 1, Line 1, Column (e). The Company recalculated the amount, as shown on Attachment Division 2-2, Page 1, Line 10, Column (e). The recalculation would decrease the shared earnings amount shown on Page 7, Line 20 of the May 9, 2022 Electric Earnings Report by \$161,000; however the Company is not proposing to revise the filing.
