## Request:

For each month from December through April for each of the last five years,

- (a) please identify the average monthly amount billed to all residential heating customers in each of those months, (including Rate 12 and Rate 13 customers together);
- (b) the actual average monthly usage in therms, associated with the average given in (a) above; and
- (c) then show the same information requested in (a) and (b) for the low income residential heating Rate 13 customers and residential heating Rate 12 customers, separately.

#### **CLARIFICATION NOTES:**

- (i) This request is seeking information regarding the bills within the billing cycle that would have been *received* by the customers in the referenced month (not the months in which the usage actually occurred). For example, a customer who consumed gas from which charges were incurred during the month of November is likely to be in a billing cycle where the customer receives a bill in December. When providing the information for December, the request is seeking the average from the bills *received* in December, even though all or a portion of the consumption occurred in November; not the bills that were sent in a billing cycle through which the customer received the bill in January for consumption occurring in whole or in part within December.
- (ii) In calculating the average bill for all residential heating customers, please use the amount that would have been billed for those customers participating in budget billing if they were not participating in budget billing, rather than the budget bill amount.
- (iii) "Monthly amount billed" is the total bill with all charges included.
