## NOTICE TO SOLICIT COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING

In July 2022, Governor McKee signed amendments to the Affordable Clean Energy Security Act that were passed by the General Assembly in June. Specifically R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-31-10 requires Rhode Island Energy to solicit proposals for "at least six hundred megawatts (600 MW) but no greater than one thousand megawatts (1,000 MW) of newly-developed offshore wind capacity no later than October 15, 2022." Rhode Island Energy was required to develop a request for proposals (RFP) in consultation with the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources and the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities and Carriers for comment by the public prior to its issuance. The law contains certain minimum requirements for the RFP. On September 7, 2022, Rhode Island Energy filed with the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) a copy of the draft RFP. The RFP is available on the PUC's website at the PUC's office and may be accessed at: https://ripuc.ri.gov/Docket-22-22-EL.
