NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) gives notice that it will continue its hearing in Docket 22-33-EE on Friday, December 16, 2022 at 9:30 A.M. in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office, 89 Jefferson Blvd., Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and from time to time as required. The hearing will be streamed live at https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg.

At this hearing, the PUC will continue to examine the propriety of The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy's (RI Energy) proposed 2023 Annual Energy Efficiency Program Plan (Annual Plan). The Annual Plan is submitted pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws 39-1-27.7(c) and the Least Cost Procurement Standards as approved by the PUC in Docket No. 5015. The Annual Plan proposes budgets to implement electric and natural gas energy efficiency programs to Rhode Island energy consumers and is funded through the Energy Efficiency Program (EEP) charge that is collected from RI Energy's electric and gas customers. RI Energy seeks approval of the Annual Plan.

The proposed 2023 Annual EEP budget for the electric programs is \$105.5 million. RI Energy proposes an EEP charge of \$0.00862 per kWh for all customers for effect January 1, 2023. The bill impact on an average residential electric customer on the A-16 rate, would see a monthly bill decrease of \$1.88 or -1.2 %. The proposed 2023 Annual EEP budget for the gas programs is \$36.9 million. RI Energy proposes an EEP charge of \$1.172 per dekatherm for residential gas customers and \$0.652 per dekatherm for commercial and industrial gas customers for effect January 1, 2023. The proposed EEP charge for electric and gas which will be collected through a fully reconciling funding mechanism. An average residential gas customer on the Residential Heating rate would see an annual bill decrease of \$15.86 or -1.0 %.
