NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 39-1-11, 42-98-9(d) and 42-98-10, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) is conducting a hearing on **Thursday, May 4, 2023 at 6:00 P.M.** at the PUC's office, Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The purpose of this hearing is to take public comments on the above subject matter. Due to the specific PUC mandate under the Energy Facility Siting Act, speakers should limit their comments to the PUC to the need and cost-justification for the proposed Facility. The evidentiary hearings will be held **May 8, 2023 and May 9, 2023 at 9:30 A.M.** The hearings may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required. People interested in providing public comment at the meeting may participate in a Zoom meeting through the internet or by calling in, preferably 5-10 minutes prior to the hearing. On April 1, 2022, The Narragansett Electric Company (Applicant) filed with the Energy Facility Siting Board (Siting Board) a Supplemental Application to its May 19, 2021 application to construct and operate a portable liquified Natural gas (LNG) Vaporization Facility. The Applicant maintains that the Facility is necessary to meet the need of maintaining a reliable natural gas distribution system on Aquidneck Island. On October 19, 2022, the Siting Board issued a Notice of Designation to the PUC to render an Advisory Opinion as to the need and cost-justification for the proposed Facility. The PUC's Advisory Opinion is not a final decision on the proposed Facility.

In this docket, the PUC will examine the propriety of the need and cost analysis recommendation submitted to the PUC by the parties, including the Division of Planning, the Office of Energy Resources and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers regarding the need and cost justification for the Applicant's proposed Facility.
