NOTICE OF TECHNICAL RECORD SESSION

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11 and §42-46-6, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a technical session on **Wednesday, May 10, 2023 at 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. This docket relates to The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy's (Rhode Island Energy or Company) proposed Advanced Metering Functionality (AMF) Business Case program proposal. The proposal includes a full scale deployment of AMF across its electric service territory in Rhode Island intended to replace existing electric automated meter reading (AMR) meters. The proposal includes capital spending and recovery through rates for expenses associated with meters, software, communications and other operating expenses.

The PUC has scheduled a series of technical sessions to explore specific topics. This is the second technical session. This technical session will be to review the various contracts executed or conditionally executed between the Company and its chosen sole source vendor. These documents were submitted in response to a request made by the PUC at the April 14, 2023, hearing on confidentiality. Specifically, discussion will include the following:
