## STATE OF RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## IN RE: VERIZON RHODE ISLAND:TARIFF FILING:DOCKET NO. 23-10-TL

## ORDER

On March 29, 2023, Verizon filed with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for increased rates to certain traditional telecommunications package offerings. The filing also increased rates for subscribers to measured lifeline service.<sup>1</sup> Order No. 19540, approving Verizon's Successor Alternative Form of Regulation Plan (Successor Plan), presented a settlement between Verizon and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers. In that order, the Commission allowed Verizon pricing flexibility, but required Verizon to continue offering measured lifeline service to customers at a charge of \$1.00 per month. This means that when Verizon increases rates, it must also increase any discount for this service to maintain the \$1.00 per month rate.<sup>2</sup> In compliance with that order, in the instant filing, Verizon also increased the amount of state support in order to maintain the \$1.00 per month charge.<sup>3</sup>

Under the approved Successor Plan, the Division is required to review Verizon's filing for consistency with Order No. 19540. The Division filed a memorandum from Joel Munoz, Assistant to Chief Accountant, indicating that the amended tariff is consistent with the order. Accordingly, the Division recommended approval for effect May 1, 2023.<sup>4</sup>
