**ORDER**

On April 10, 2023, DISH Wireless, L.L.C. d/b/a GenMobile (Company) filed with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for registration to transact as a Class II Telecommunication Service Provider<sup>1</sup> pursuant to the entry requirements for telecommunications service providers adopted by the PUC.<sup>2</sup> The application included the Company's statement of business operations and proposed service.

On April 28, 2023, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) filed a memorandum indicating that the Company has complied with the filing requirements necessary to obtain authorization to operate as a provider of telecommunications service and recommended approval of the Company's application.

At an Open Meeting held May 15, 2023, the Commission found the Company's application to be proper, reasonable, and in the interest of ratepayers. The PUC approved the Company's application.

Accordingly, it is hereby

(24657) ORDERED:

- 1) The application for registration to operate as a Class II Telecommunication Supplier filed by DISH Wireless L.L.C. d/b/a GenMobile is approved.
