In the docket, the PUC will examine the propriety of a tariff advice filing by The Narragansett Electric Company's d/b/a Rhode Island Energy's (RIE) to Amend the Net Metering Provision and Proposal for Administration of Excess Net Metering Credits. Specifically, Rhode Island Energy proposes a solution to improve the administration of excess net metering credit on a prospective basis. The proposal includes administrative timing for implementing the changes. The proposal seeks to define the implementation process for the administration of net metering and mitigate future issues of excess balances.
