NOTICE OF ORAL ARGUMENTS

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-6(b) and 39-1-1, the Public Utilities Commission’s (PUC) hereby gives notice that on **Monday, August 28, 2023 at 1:00 P.M.** in Hearing Room A at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island, it will conduct a hearing for the purpose of taking oral arguments regarding requests for extension of time and the potential impact on the procedural schedule in this docket. The hearing will be live streamed at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

This docket relates to The Narragansett Electric Company’s d/b/a Rhode Island Energy’s (RIE) Tariff Advice to Amend the Net Metering Provision and Proposal for Administration of Excess Net Metering Credits. The PUC has issued a procedural schedule requiring any pre-filed testimony be filed by August 23, 2023, and scheduled an evidentiary hearing for September 21, 2023. MassAmerican Energy LLC d/b/a Gridwealth Development (MAE) and Revity Energy LLC (Revity) have requested extensions of time to file pre-filed testimony in this docket. MAE and Revity’s request for a 30-day extension to file pre-filed testimony would, if granted, necessitate a rescheduling of the hearing date. The Commission has suspended the deadline to file pre-filed testimony pending the oral arguments on August 28, 2023. Pursuant to Commission Rule 1.21(C), the hearing shall be conducted by the Chairman of the Commission, as presiding officer. A ruling may be made on any extension requests and, if necessary, adjustments may be made to the procedural schedule at the hearing.
