

Request:

Please provide a detailed description and all associated costs for the restoration work associated with the Atwells Avenue Main Replacement project.

Response:

For the final restoration costs incurred on the Atwells Avenue project in FY 2023, approximately \$1.868 million was paid for restoration work performed by contractors, \$0.179 million was for flaggers, \$0.140 million was for police details, and \$0.411 million was for capital overheads. The final restoration work performed on the Atwells Avenue was done to meet the restoration requirements of the City of Providence to restore areas that were disturbed during the project's main and service replacements. The restoration work performed in FY2023 primarily consisted of specialty paver work in the roadway at four intersection locations as shown in the photographs below. The work included paver and granite crosswalks, line striping and minor restoration of the asphalt roadway and was supported by flaggers and police details as necessary.

The major cost categories of the restoration performed by contractors, including flaggers and police details, and the associated costs, are shown in the following table:

Crosswalks (Pavers and Granite)	\$0.465M
Materials (Pavers, Granite, etc)	\$0.347M

Total	\$2.187M
