Explain the basis for the assessment of those demand charges.
- **Response:** Please see Div. 5-1 Attachment (Excel Spreadsheet), which modifies the Excel electricity spreadsheet attached to DIV 1-6 by incorporating distribution and transmission demand charge columns where appropriate.

According to Rhode Island Energy, a demand charge is "a type of electric charge assessed to industrial/commercial customers based on the maximum amount of power the customer requires over a single hour for a given month. This is different from a typical volumetric electric charge which is based on the amount of energy consumed over an entire month. Demand charges are measured in kilowatts (kW) and are charged at a dollar rate per kW which is generally much higher than a unit cost of consumption per hour."
