I. Call to Order

II. Telecommunications Service Providers – The following providers of telecommunications services have reported that they have no customers in Rhode Island, have ceased operations and requested that their registration to conduct business be cancelled. The PUC will vote on the requests submitted in:

- Docket No. 5146 – Automated Business Machines, Inc.
- Docket No. 2262(I19) – Telecom Management, Inc. d/b/a Pioneer Telephone

III. Docket No. RES-23-19 – NBD OCPC LLC – The Company submitted an application for eligibility of the Lincoln RI Generation Unit, a 0.360 MW AC (0.48069 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Lincoln, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource. PUC consultant recommends approval. The PUC will review and vote on the application.

IV. Docket No. 23-05-EL – The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a Rhode Island Energy – In this docket, Rhode Island Energy submitted a tariff filing to amend the Company's Net Metering Provision and a proposal for the administration of excess net metering credits. The PUC will discuss, review the record and vote on the Company's proposed tariff filing.
