NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

On December 1, 2023, the Green Mile Solar, LLC, MSD Wiscasset LLC, MEVS Waterville LLC and MEVS Richards (collectively, the Applicants), community net metering projects located in Maine, filed a request for a waiver from 810-RICR-40-05-2.6(H), to allow the net metering facilities to qualify as an eligible renewable energy facility in Rhode Island. Previously, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) has interpreted the Renewable Energy Standard (RES) (R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26-1 to 10) as requiring net metering facilities, even if grid-connected, to be located in Rhode Island. In 2022, the law eliminated the requirement that customer-sited generation facilities must be located in Rhode Island in order to qualify as an eligible renewable energy resource under the RES. Because the PUC has not yet revised the rules governing the Implementation of a Renewable Energy Standard (810-RICR-40-05-1), the Applicants requested the PUC waive or otherwise determine inapplicable the requirement in 810-RICR-40-05-2.6(H) to allow a final review of their applications.
