**Re: Docket No. 24-10-EL - The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy Tariff Advice to Amend the Net Metering Provision**

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On March 1, 2024, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (“Rhode Island Energy” or “Company”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) its tariff advice to propose changes to the Company’s Net Metering Provision tariff. The filing was in accordance with 810-RICR-00-00-1.10(C) and in compliance with the directives that were issued by the Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) at an Open Meeting that occurred on January 12, 2024. This memo is prepared to document my review of the proposed revisions.

The primary purpose of the proposed revisions is to reflect the amendments made to the Net Metering Law during the 2023 legislative session. This included the addition of and edits to definitions in the tariff as well as key terms and conditions. It also included some clarifying changes and reordering of the tariff.

I have reviewed the filing made by the Company and find the proposed tariff to be both consistent with the changes in law and appropriate. I recommend that the Division support the Company’s filing and recommend to the PUC approval of the proposed Net Metering Tariff as drafted.
