**NOTICE OF HEARING (continued)**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-3 and 42-35-9, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) is conducting a hearing on **Tuesday, July 9, 2024 at 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, R.I. This is a continuation of the hearing held on June 6, 2024. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and from time to time as required. On October 17, 2023, The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (RI Energy) filed two Petitions for Acceleration of a System Modification Due to Distributed Generation Projects. The first was in connection with a Tiverton Project (Docket No. 23-37-EL) and the second in connection to Weaver Hill Projects (Docket No. 23-38-EL). The Petitions are filed pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.3-4.1 entitled Interconnection Standards (the Interconnection Statute) and Section 5.4 of RIPUC No. 2258 entitled The Narragansett Electric Company Standards for Connecting Distributed Generation.

The interconnection request that is the subject of the Petition for the Tiverton Project was made by Green Development, LLC in connection with 11,791 kW photovoltaic systems located at 390 Brayton Road, Tiverton, Rhode Island. The interconnection requests that are the subject of the Petition for the Weaver Hill Projects were made by Green Development, LLC, Robin Hollow Solar LLC and Studley Solar LLC. Revity Energy LLC is an affiliate of Robin Hollow Solar and Studley Solar with common ownership and/or control with each. These projects (Nooseneck Projects, Robin Hollow Project, and Studley Solar Project) are located in West Greenwich, Rhode Island.
