**SUBJECT:** R.I.P.U.C. Docket No. 24-06-EE - The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a Rhode Island Energy's System Reliability Procurement Investment Proposal for Electric Demand Response 2024-2026-ConnectedSolutions

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On July 3, 2024, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (the "Company") filed with the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") a Compliance Filing in which it calculated a System Reliability Procurement ("SRP") factor of \$0.00165 per kWh to take effect starting August 1, 2024, through December 31, 2026 ("Implementation Period") in support of its SRP Investment Proposal for Electric Demand Response – ConnectedSolutions program.

The Division has reviewed the filing and concluded that the Company correctly calculated the proposed SRP factor in accordance with the decision of the Commission at its July 1, 2024 Open Meeting. The Division recommends approval of the proposed factor of \$0.00165/kWh to go into effect for the Implementation Period as filed.
