The Board will discuss and/or vote on the matters listed below. Because this Open Meeting is not a hearing, the Board will not be accepting oral public comments. - **Docket No. SB-2024-02 - The Narragansett Electric Company's Notice of Intent Application for the Tiverton Tap Rebuild Project in Tiverton, Rhode Island**

The Narragansett Electric Company filed a Notice of Intent Application on June 21, 2024, to rebuild existing transmission lines in the Town of Tiverton, RI. The Board will consider, deliberate and may rule on whether the proposed project constitutes an alteration of a major energy facility as defined by R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-98-4(b) and if it will result in a significant impact on the environment or public health, safety, and welfare.

- **Docket No. SB-2024-03 - The Narragansett Electric Company's Notice of Intent Application for the S171N/T172N Woonsocket to West Farnum Rebuild**

The Narragansett Electric Company filed a Notice of Intent Application on June 21, 2024 to rebuild and construct new transmission lines in the Town of North Smithfield, RI. The Board will consider, deliberate, and may rule on whether the proposed project constitutes an alteration of a major energy facility as defined by R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-98-4(b) and if it will result in a significant impact on the environment or public health, safety, and welfare.

- **Docket No. SB-2024-01 – Quonset Development Corporation Petition for Declaratory Order**

A Petition for a Declaratory Order was filed by the Quonset Development Corporation on April 17, 2024 requesting the Board to rule that a proposed battery energy storage system at the Quonset Business Park in the Town of North Kingstown, Rhode Island is not subject to the jurisdiction of the Board as defined by R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-98-3, § 42-98-4 and 445-RICR-00-00-1-1.3(A)(16) of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure. The Board conducted an evidentiary hearing on July 11, 2024. The Board will consider and deliberate on the evidence presented and may vote on the Quonset Development Corporation's Petition for Declaratory Order.
