- All electricity generated within the ISO New England (ISO-NE) control area and fed on to the New England grid, as well as electricity exchanged between ISO-NE and adjacent control areas, is tracked via the New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System (GIS). For each megawatt hour (MWh) of electricity generated within or exchanged between the ISO-NE control area, whether renewable or not, one serial-numbered, electronic GIS certificate is created. The GIS certificate represents all attributes or characteristics, such as fuel source, air emissions, location, etc. of that one MWh of electricity. The information in this Energy Source Disclosure is based on GIS Certificates obtained and retired by the Supplier. For detail about these attributes please see [insert link or directions for more detail].
- Renewable Energy Standard (RES): is defined in the R.I. Gen Laws 39-26. The GIS certificates are retired by June 15th of the following year.

Generation sources that qualify for the RES are known as RI New and must be built after 1997 and be located within or delivered to New England (2% may come from sources built prior to 1997, called RI Existing). The South Kingstown Program sources all voluntary renewable energy, above the RES, from sources that qualify as RI New, come from solar, wind, anaerobic digestion, and low-impact hydro, and are located only within New England.

  - You may leave the Program or switch to a different program option at any time, without penalty.

**SOUTH KINGSTOWN, RI — The South Kingstown Community Electricity program announced its new winter electricity supply prices, going into effect with the first November meter read.**

Town officials said the new prices are fixed for six months and will be adjusted to summer rates in May 2024. Current participants do not need to take any action to remain in the program and receive the new pricing for the product in which they are currently enrolled.

According to town officials, most participants in South Kingstown’s program use “South Kingstown Standard” which provides more renewable energy than RI Energy’s "Last Resort" service, will still provide cost savings this winter.

The town is part of a group of seven cities and towns in Rhode Island which launched the state’s first municipal aggregation programs: Barrington, Central Falls, Narragansett, Newport, Portsmouth, Providence and South Kingstown. Each community launched their own distinct program in May 2023, but combined their buying power to procure a common electricity supplier, Next Era Energy Services.

Town officials said the vast majority of South Kingstown's residential electricity users enrolled in the program and collectively participants saved

energy facilities in Rhode Island. Savings upwards of \$100,000 are expected by the end of the first six-month pricing term, city officials said.

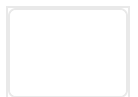

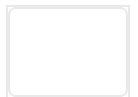

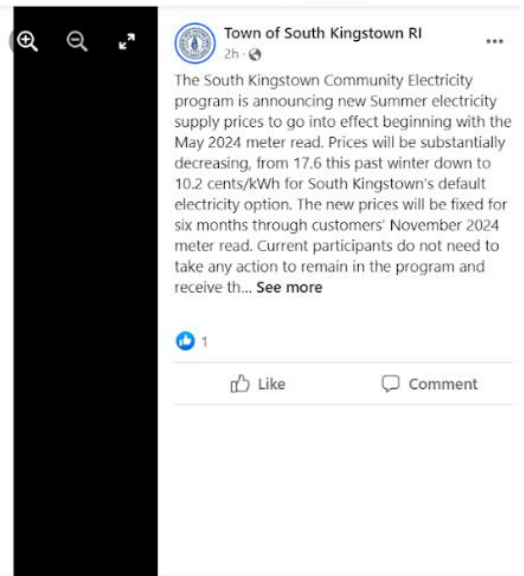
