NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a public hearing on **October 8, 2024 at 6:00 P.M. at Pascoag Utility District, 253 Main Street, Pascoag, Rhode Island**. The purpose of this hearing is to accept public comment on the Pascoag Utility District's proposed application to increase rates.

In this docket, Pascoag Utility District filed an application to implement new base distribution rates and schedules designed to collect additional revenue requirement in the amount of \$444,918 or 4.73% over current revenue levels. The impact of proposed rates for typical residential customer using 500 kWh per month is an increase of \$4.18 or 4.75 %, from \$88.08 to \$92.26 per month. The impact on other customers will vary depending upon the rate class and usage.

The application is on file for examination at the PUC's office and at the office of Pascoag Utility District located at 253 Main Street, Pascoag, Rhode Island. The application can also be accessed at <https://ripuc.ri.gov/Docket-24-14-EL>. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
