**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE FOR REQUEST  
FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS, AND  
DEADLINE TO IDENTIFY DESIGNATED STAKEHOLDERS**

Through this Supplemental Notice, in addition to the prompts contained in the original notice issued on November 22, 2024, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) invites stakeholders to also comment on the Wholesale Distribution Tariffs recently approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) by Monday, December 23, 2024. This is an open-ended prompt where stakeholders can either comment on specific aspects of the approved tariff or can incorporate their comments on the tariff into relevant prompts from the November 22<sup>nd</sup> Notice. Staff of the Public Utilities Commission held a public workshop on **Wednesday, December 4, 2024, at 10:00 AM**. As discussed at the Workshop, FERC recently issued a decision on Connecticut’s tariff for storage resources. On September 30, 2024, Connecticut Light and Power Company (CLP) and NSTAR submitted separate proposed Wholesale Distribution Tariffs, “that establish the rates, terms, and conditions for the provision of Wholesale Distribution Service (WDS) to eligible customers who own electric energy storage systems (ESS) connected to the Filing Parties’ distribution systems.” On November 27, 2024, FERC issued an order accepting the wholesale distribution tariffs for CLP and NSTAR Electric Company.
