On behalf of The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (the “Company”), this letter serves as notice to the Rhode Island Energy Facility Siting Board and the Public Utilities Commission that the Company’s mobile liquefied natural gas facility located at 111 Old Mill Lane in Portsmouth provided additional natural gas supply to Aquidneck Island’s natural gas distribution system. Below is a summary of the recent event.

Reason for vaporization	Incremental supply needed for peak hour load to manage increased system demand caused by weather fluctuations.

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Notes	The backup vaporizer was utilized for a brief period while valve maintenance was performed on the primary vaporizer's pumping unit. After maintenance was completed, the primary vaporizer was used until vaporization was completed for the day. The Company is not aware of any noise complaints from this operation.
