- III. **Docket No. - 25-08-GE – The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (Company)** – This docket relates to PUC's inquiry into Rhode Island Energy's billing systems practices and performance. On May 16, 2025, the Commission directed the Company to engage a consultant to assist the Commission in evaluating: (i) the operational status, accuracy, and effectiveness of the Company's electric and gas billing systems (including the format, calculations depicted on the bills, and any other information provided on the bills that would impact the customer's understanding of how the charges were determined); (ii) the operation of the back-office systems, meter data management system, and any other systems or processes that relate to producing accurate electric and gas bills to customers; (iii) the consistency between kilowatt-hours billed by the Company at retail and kilowatt-hours reported by the Company to ISO New England; and (iv) the reliability of the billing systems for purposes of determining billed revenue that is used for financial and rate accounting.

On May 30, 2025, consistent with the Commission's directive, the Company filed a draft Request for Proposals and form proposed Professional Services Agreement for Commission review. At this open meeting, the Commission will review the documents and may vote on whether to approve them as filed or with modifications.
