

**MOTION FOR INTERVENTION OF
GOOD ENERGY, L.P.**

I. Introduction

Pursuant to Rule 1.14 of the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure (R.I. Code of Regulations, Title 810, Chapter 00, Subchapter 00, Part 1, Section 1.14), Good Energy, L.P. ("Good Energy") respectfully files its Motion for Intervention in this docket.

On May 12, 2025, The Narragansett Electrical Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (the "Company" or "Rhode Island Energy") filed its plans for Green Button Connect ("GBC"), Home Area Network ("HAN") and Grid-Edge Computing ("edge-computing") as required by the Commission as part of its approval of the Company's Advanced Metering Functionality Business Case in Docket No. 22-49-EL. On July 18, 2025 the Commission issued a procedural schedule for this docket, with motions to intervene to be submitted by August 8, 2025.

Good Energy contacted Rhode Island Energy to determine whether the Company objected to Good Energy's proposed intervention in this Docket. The Company indicated that it would like to reserve its rights.

II. Intervention – Interest, Grounds and Position

Good Energy is the municipal aggregation consultant to the Cities of Providence, Newport and Central Falls, and the Towns of Narragansett, Portsmouth, South Kingstown,

Barrington, Bristol, Middletown, and North Kingstown, all of which have Commission-approved aggregation programs. Providence, Newport, Central Falls, Narragansett, Portsmouth, South Kingston and Barrington are fully operating their aggregation programs in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-3-1.2. Bristol, Middletown and North Kingstown have PUC-approved aggregation plans and are assessing the timing of their launch.

According to Commission Rule 1.14, any person claiming an interest of such nature that intervention is necessary or appropriate may intervene in a Commission proceeding. Intervention is appropriate if the person's interest may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing parties, and as to which movants may be bound by the Commission's action in the proceeding. Intervention is also appropriate if their interest is of such nature that movant's participation may be in the public interest.

Good Energy seeks to intervene in this docket given that the municipalities identified above, and the competitive electricity suppliers it works with, are directly affected and bound by the Commission's action regarding Rhode Island Energy's GBC, HAN and edge computing proposals. For example, the Company is proposing to implement GBC to provide customers with the ability to share their energy usage information with third-party vendors, and the Company is creating a set of criteria that the third-party vendors must meet in order to be approved (Green Button Connect Plan, at 6). It is important that suppliers for the municipal aggregation programs and other appropriate third-party vendors will have access to such data in order to provide services to the aggregation participants. Similarly, with regard to the Home Area Network and the edge computing proposals, RIE has partnered with Sense for its mobile application and Landis+Gyr for its App Ecosystem. Good Energy seeks to intervene in this docket to engage with the Commission and the Company to ensure that the municipal-aggregation communities


and electricity suppliers can work with the proposed technology and programs, which will drive additional benefits and innovation for Rhode Island residents, whether they live in a municipality with an active aggregation program today or may participate in one in the future. Good Energy's work and understanding of these proposals on behalf of the cities and towns of Providence, Newport, Central Falls, Narragansett, Portsmouth, South Kingstown, Barrington, Bristol, Middletown, and North Kingstown is in the public interest.

III. Conclusion

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Good Energy respectfully requests that its unopposed motion to intervene in this docket be granted.


