Curt Stamp Biography

Curt Stamp is Vice President of Government and Regulatory Affairs for Cox Enterprises. In this role he is responsible for state and local government and regulatory affairs for all of Cox's divisions.

Before assuming this role in January 2025, he served as Vice President of Government and Regulatory Affairs for Cox Communications. Previously, he was Vice President of Government Affairs for the Cox Central Region, including Arkansas, Kansas, Idaho, Iowa, Nebraska and Oklahoma and was the Arkansas Market Vice President, where he was the local senior executive responsible for cross-functional engagement with employees, community and business leaders and customers. His first role at Cox was as Director of Regulatory Affairs for Cox Communications in Oklahoma, Kansas and Arkansas.

Prior to that, he was President of the Independent Telephone and Telecommunications Alliance, the national trade association for mid-sized Local Exchange Carriers. From 2005-2007, Curt served as a Commissioner on the Iowa Utilities Commission, the three-member panel responsible for the regulation of Iowa's gas, electric, telecommunications and water utilities.

Curt has been an attorney in private practice and has held several telecommunications policy positions in the public and private sectors. He received his BA and MBA from Iowa State University and his JD from Drake University Law School.
