**REQUEST AS 2-2**

When did Cox start charging municipalities for cablecasting live municipal meetings (town council, school committee, *etc.*)?

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-2**

Cox does not provide live cablecasting services to municipalities in Rhode Island.

**REQUEST AS 2-3**

Please identify all municipalities that Cox charges for cablecasting live municipal meetings.

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-3**

As noted above, Cox does not provide live cablecasting to municipalities in Rhode Island, and therefore does not charge any municipalities for such service. That said, Cox provides two municipalities in Rhode Island—South Kingstown and Woonsocket—with dedicated, one-way video transport connections between the demarcation points at their respective town halls and a video broadcast facility, which the municipalities use to broadcast their municipal meetings. Cox is not involved in the recording or editing of the footage of these municipal meetings.

For each municipality identified in AS 2-3, indicate: (a) if Cox maintains an agreement or contract that permits Cox to charge the municipality for cablecasting live municipal meetings, and (b) please provide each agreement or contract.

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-4**

As noted above, Cox does not provide live cablecasting to municipalities in Rhode Island, but does provide dedicated, one-way video transport to the municipalities of South Kingstown and Woonsocket. Cox's contract with South Kingstown to provide the dedicated, one-way video transport connection described above is provided as Confidential Attachment A. Cox provides dedicated, one-way video transport to Woonsocket pursuant to similar terms and conditions.

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-5**

South Kingstown and Woonsocket, the two municipalities that lease dedicated, one-way video transport connections from Cox, are billed for a single service, coded "video transport – 1 way – intrastate." Please describe how municipalities are billed for the charges identified in AS 2-5.

Each of South Kingstown and Woonsocket is invoiced monthly for [BEGIN CONFIDENTIAL] [REDACTED] [END CONFIDENTIAL] for the dedicated, one-way video transport connection that it leases from Cox.

**REQUEST AS 2-7**

Please provide all documentation that Cox possesses providing Division authorization to Cox to charge municipalities for cablecasting live municipal meetings.

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-7**

As noted above, Cox does not provide live cablecasting to municipalities in Rhode Island, but instead provides two municipalities in Rhode Island with dedicated, one-way video transport connections. Cox provides this service at the same price and subject to the same terms and conditions applicable to its commercial communications offerings.

**REQUEST AS 2-8**

Where will the call center for Rhode Island be located after the transaction is consummated? Will the call center be dedicated to Rhode Island. If not. Why not? Please explain.

**JOINT APPLICANTS' RESPONSE: AS 2-8**

Cox operates a sales and service call center at 9 JP Murphy Hwy, West Warwick, RI 02893. Agents in this call center handle calls from across the Cox service territory, including but not limited to Rhode Island customers. Charter today operates its call centers in a similar manner, fielding calls from all over the country regardless of where the call center is located.

The Joint Applicants have not developed any plans to close the Cox call center identified in this response. At this time, the Joint Applicants are in the early stages of integration planning and remain focused on securing the necessary regulatory consents needed to complete the Transaction. As a result, the Joint Applicants do not have definitive answers regarding anticipated locations of call centers following the Transaction. Charter today maintains, and plans after the closing of the Transaction to have, a 100 percent U.S.-based sales and customer service employee workforce. Joint Applicants are committed to seamlessly transitioning operations to the combined company while minimizing any workforce or customer disruptions.
