**MOTION OF THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY
d/b/a RHODE ISLAND ENERGY FOR EXTENSION OF TRANSFORMER AUDIT
TO COMPLY WITH ORDER**

The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (the “Company”) hereby respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) grant the Company an extension to January 30, 2026, for the Company to complete its audit of transformer and related equipment and report the results to the PUC and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (“Division”) in compliance with PUC Order No. 25551, ¶ 2, in Docket No. 23-48-EL. The current due date is December 24, 2025. The Company reached out to counsel for the Division, and they did not have any objections to the requested extension.

I. APPLICABLE ORDER

The order from which the Company seeks relief is PUC Order No. 25551, which was issued on November 6, 2025. Specifically, ¶ 2 is the applicable directive and provides that “[t]he Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy shall perform an audit of the Transformer and Related Equipment category from the date of the PPL acquisition through FY 2025 and report the results to the Public Utilities Commission and Division of Public Utilities and Carriers within ninety (90) days [of the Open Meeting decision made on September 25, 2025 which calculates to December 24, 2025].”

II. LEGAL STANDARD

810-RICR-00-00-1.7(B)¹ provides that “... whenever by any Commission rule, regulation, or order, or any notice given thereunder, an act is required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may, for good cause, be extended by the presiding officer upon request made before expiration of the period originally prescribed or as previously extended...” In this case, the Company is requesting an extension to comply with ¶ 2 of PUC Order No. 25551 for good cause, as explained herein.

III. GOOD CAUSE FOR REQUESTED EXTENSION

The Company is diligently performing an internal audit of procurement processes, inventory practices, installation procedures and regulatory reporting for Transformers and Related Equipment, looking at the period from the date of the Acquisition² through the end of Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2025. The audit entails certain tasks that will require time to complete such that meeting a due date of December 24, 2025 will be challenging. These tasks include requesting and reconciling data from National Grid and consulting with various departments within the Company including but not limited to plant accounting, supply chain, and personnel responsible for the electric infrastructure, safety, and reliability (“ISR”) plan. The Company anticipates that a due date of January 30, 2026 will allow enough time for the Company to complete a thorough audit.

² The “Acquisition” means PPL Rhode Island Holdings, LLC’s acquisition of 100 percent of the outstanding shares of common stock of The Narragansett Electric Company from National Grid USA on May 25, 2022.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Company respectfully requests that the PUC grant this Motion for extension.




