NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) will conduct a public hearing on **Thursday, November 20, 2025, at 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room B at the Division’s office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. At this hearing, the Division will consider the Joint Application of Charter Communications, Inc. (Charter), Cox Enterprises, Inc. (CEI), and Cox Communications, Inc. (Cox) to Transfer Control of CoxCom, LLC’s (CoxCom) Certificates for Authority to Operate for CATV Service Areas 1-8 and for CoxCom, LLC to Participate in Financing Arrangements. The parties request that the Division Administrator approve a proposed transaction that will result in a transfer of “substantial control” of Cox’s subsidiary CoxCom, which holds Certificates of Authority to Operate and related Certificates of Construction and Compliance Order Certificates for CATV Service Areas 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, from CEI to Charter. CoxCom will retain its Certificates of Authority and continue operations in Rhode Island while ultimate control and ownership of CoxCom will be transferring from CEI to Charter as a result of the transaction, resulting in a transfer of substantial control of the Certificates. The parties also seek the Division Administrator’s consent to a pledge of CoxCom’s Rhode Island cable assets for financing purposes that will result from CoxCom becoming a subsidiary of Charter pursuant to the same transaction.

Reference is made to R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 39-1, 39-3, 39-19, 42-35 and the Division’s Rules Governing Community Antenna Television Systems (815-RICR-10-05-1).
