NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of Rhode Island Gen. Laws § 39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC or Commission) will conduct a hearing on **December 18, 2025, at 11:30 a.m.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's offices located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from time to time as required. The hearing will be streamed live at https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg and recorded. The Commission will receive public comment from members of the public at the start of the hearing. In this docket, the Commission will examine the Block Island Utility District d/b/a Block Island Power Company's (BIUD) proposed energy procurement plan to obtain competitively-priced wholesale power supply to meet its Last Resort Service (also known as Power Supply Service requirements) and BIUD's proposed rate changes arising out of the twelve month reconciliation period of BIUD's tariff adjustment provisions for the Last Resort Service and transmission rates. The requested effective date is January 1, 2026. The impact of the proposal on a residential customer taking Last Resort Service and using 500 kWh per month is:

- For the months of November through April, an increase of \$3.75 (from \$141.75 to \$145.50).
- For the months of May, June, September, and October, an increase of \$3.75 (from \$168.25 to \$172.00).
- For the months of July and August, an increase of \$3.75 (from \$239.50 to \$243.25).

Reference is made to chapters 39-1, 39-1, and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws. The PUC is accessible to persons with disabilities.
