Company's Position

On January 16, 2026, operations personnel from the Company and the Petitioners had a meeting during which significant progress was made with respect to the Petitioner's prayer for relief. The Company (1) Committed to issuing Central Pike its final reconciliation payment by January 30, 2026 pending comments on the Final Accounting Report ("FAR") from Central Pike; (2) Has issued Central South an interconnection design on January 6, 2026; and (3) Has processed final reconciliation payments for Case Nos. 518476 and 538025 on January 20, 2026 for Jenckes Hill Solar. In addition, the Company and Revity Energy LLC and affiliates ("Revity") agreed to participate in monthly meetings so that Revity can be kept up to date on all items related to interconnection processes, program management, and reconciliations. In light of the recent progress that has been made and subject to the Company satisfying the commitments described above, the Company's position is that this matter does not need to proceed through the formal dispute resolution process and can be resolved informally between the Parties.

Central Pike

For Central Pike, the dispute centers on the Company's failure to timely issue the FAR and the corresponding reconciliation payment. Although the Company stated that the FAR would be issued on July 14, 2025, it did not meet that date. The reasons for the delay were a misunderstanding of Company personnel of the reconciliation process as well as challenges with obtaining information from new Company systems given the age of this project. The Company acknowledges that Central Pike is entitled to a significant reconciliation payment totaling \$370,399.55. The Company committed to issuing the FAR by January 13, 2026 and, as indicated above, will make the associated reconciliation payment by January 30, 2026 provided that Revity has no further concerns with the FAR.

Central South

For Central South, the dispute concerns the Company's failure to timely complete the interconnection distribution line design required under the Interconnection Service Agreement ("ISA"). The ISA provides that the distribution line design would be completed within 11 weeks of the execution of the ISA. The ISA's anticipated date for full interconnection is March 11, 2026. There were project specific complexities with design and distribution planning and asset management ("DPAM") causing a slight delay. As indicated above, the Company has completed the distribution line design as of January 6, 2026. The Company will act expeditiously towards a March 2026 service date.

Jenckes Hill Solar

For Jenckes Hill Solar, the dispute arises from the Company's failure to issue the required reconciliation payments following its issuance of two FARs on August 5, 2025. The FARs concluded that Jenckes Hill Solar was entitled to refunds of \$75,784.34 in Case No. 518476 and \$122,846.61 in Case No. 538025. The Company needs to complete the reconciliation for a third case which was part of the broader Jenckes Hill Solar project. As indicated above, the Company processed the two payments on January 20, 2026. The Company expects Reivity will receive the payments in the next few days.

Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, the Company requests that this matter does not proceed any further through the formal dispute resolution process provided that Petitioners may re-open this matter if the Company fails to meet its commitments described herein.

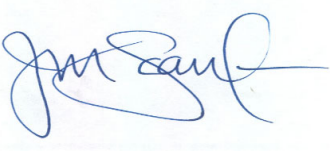
