RE-NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws §39-3-15 and §39-3-17, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) will conduct a public hearing on **Thursday, February 5, 2026, at 2:00 P.M.** in Hearing Room B of the Division, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the Division will examine the propriety of an application filed by the Providence Water Supply Board seeking consent and approval to obtain financing in an amount of \$26,200,000 through revenue bonds to be sold by the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds will be used to clean, line, and/or replace water mains located throughout the Providence Water distribution system.

The application is on file and may be examined at the Division office and at the office of the Providence Water Supply Board, 125 Dupont Drive, Providence, Rhode Island. The application can also be accessed at <https://ripuc.ri.gov/node/17746>. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
