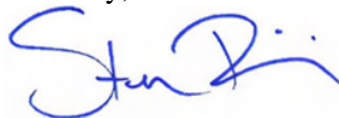

Request:

Please provide more information on reason for and calculation of the PY 2024 Property Tax Rate True-up referenced on schedule NECO-3 page 1, line (14).

Response:

At the time of the Company's June 30, 2025 PY 2024 Reconciliation filing in Docket No. 25-23-REG, the property tax factor was an estimate based on the last known property tax rate. The Company updated this factor in the Company's FY 2025 Electric Infrastructure, Safety, and Reliability ("ISR") Annual Reconciliation filing that was filed with the Commission on August 1, 2025 in Docket No. 23-48-EL. Due to the timing of the original filing and the actual property tax rate calculated in the ISR Annual Reconciliation filing an adjustment was necessary to calculate the correct property tax on the capital investment.

Request:

Referencing NECO-3, page 38:

- a. Please provide information on why the number of meters indicated on line (1) in Program Year 2025 is so much higher than the prior two program years and the projected number of meters for Program Year 2026;
- b. Please explain why the "cost per meter" estimates in line (2) increase from \$34.53 in Program Year 2023 to \$41 in Program Year 2024 and then decrease back to \$34.53 in Program Year 2025 and then back to \$41 in Program Year 2026.

Response:

- a. The Company's forecast of meter installations for Program Year 2025 (i.e., April 2025 through March 2026) was based on a three year average using the actual number of meters from Program Years 2021 through 2023 and will be updated with the actual number of meters in the Company's 2026 Renewable Energy Growth Program Reconciliation Factor Filing, which will reconcile actual RE Growth Program revenue and costs for Program Year 2025 (i.e., April 2025 through March 2026).
- b. The Company used an estimate of \$34.53 for the per meter cost for Program Year 2025 (i.e., April 2025 through March 2026) based on the actual per meter cost for Program Year 2023 and will update the actual cost per meter in the Company's 2026 Renewable Energy Growth Program Reconciliation Factor Filing, which will reconcile actual RE Growth Program revenue and costs for Program Year 2025 (i.e., April 2025 through March 2026).
