Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island Open Meetings Act, R.I.G.L. 42-46-6 (b), the public is hereby notified that the Public Utilities Commission (Commission or PUC) is holding an open meeting on **Wednesday, March 4, 2026 @ 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island for purpose of discussing, deliberating and/or voting on the following dockets. - II. **Docket No. 25-19-EL – The Narragansett Electric d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (Company)** – This docket pertains to the Company’s compliance filing stemming from its Advanced Metering Functionality Business Case in Docket No. 22-49-EL. Intervenor Mission:data Coalition requested an evidentiary hearing and submitted pre-filed direct testimony. The Company moved to strike portions of Mission:data Coalition’s direct testimony. At this Open Meeting, the Commission will review the filings, and votes may be taken
- III. **Docket No. 25-30-WW – Veolia Water Rhode Island, Inc (Company)** – This docket pertains to Veolia Water’s application to change rate schedules. The Town of South Kingstown and the Town of Narragansett moved to intervene on February 2, 2026. At this Open Meeting, the Commission will review the filings, and votes may be taken
- IV. **Consent Agenda** – All items listed within the Consent Agenda are to be considered routine by the Commission and will ordinarily be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Commission requests, in which event the item will be removed for separate consideration later on the agenda. As noted below, the agenda includes applications for eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource and PUC consultant’s recommendation on the applications.

RES-26-03	SE Condor Holdings I, LLC	Application for eligibility of the Fairmount Realty, LLC, Solar Generation Unit .180 MW AC (.2496 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Woonsocket, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends approval.
