Record Request 1

Request:

Provide an updated construction schedule using December 31, 2026 as the date that permitting is completed.

Response:

Construction would commence March 2027 and would be completed March 2028. Based on this schedule the rebuilt facilities would be in service in April 2028.

Record Request 2

Request:

How many residential homes are located within 100 feet of the transmission line right of way ("ROW")? How many residential homes are located within 100 feet of transmission line structures?

Response:

The number of residences within 100 feet of the right-of-way ("ROW"), including all residences within 100 feet of the limits of easement the Company has for the project, is 94 residential homes.

The number of residences within 100 feet of existing poles, including all residences within 100 feet of both the existing Q143 Line and the R144 Line, is 16 residential homes.

The number of residences within 100 feet of the proposed poles, including all residences within 100 feet of the rebuilt Q143 Line and R144 Line using double circuit structures, is 15 residential homes.

The Company utilized 2023 parcel information that was obtained from assessor's records together with RIGIS. FACILITY_Building_Footprints_2022_spf.
