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**MOTION FOR INTERVENTION OF  
THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY**

Pursuant to Rule 1.10 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Energy Facility Siting Board (the “Board” or “EFSB”), The Narragansett Electric Company (the “Company”), respectfully files this Motion for Intervention. On January 23, 2026, the EFSB opened Docket SB-2026-02, regarding the proposal of Quonset Development Corporation and GDQ ESS, LLC (jointly, the “Applicant”) to construct and operate a 208-megawatt battery energy storage facility at 545 Callahan Road, North Kingstown, Rhode Island (the “Battery Energy Storage Facility”). In its Application to the Board, the Applicant seeks Board approval for the following three major components of the Battery Energy Storage Facility:

- (1) battery energy storage facility with substation (“Battery Storage Facility”);
- (2) electrical transmission duct bank (“Duct Bank”); and
- (3) electrical switchyard and 115 kV voltage transmission lines connecting the switchyard to the transmission system (collectively, the “Interconnection Facilities”).

Once constructed, the Company is the proposed owner and operator of the Interconnection Facilities. Accordingly, the Company has a strong, direct interest in this proceeding.


Intervention in the Board's proceedings is governed by EFSB Rule 1.10. The Company is seeking intervention pursuant to EFSB Rule 1.10(b)(2) because the Applicant's proposed facility includes Interconnection Facilities that will be owned and operated by the Company once constructed. The Company's interests are directly affected by this proceeding, are not adequately represented by the existing parties, and the Board's action in the proceeding may be binding on the Company.

WHEREFORE, The Narragansett Electric Company hereby respectfully requests to be granted leave to intervene in this proceeding as a full party.
