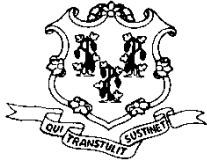

DECISION

DECISION

I. INTRODUCTION

A. SUMMARY

In this Decision, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority determines that the wind generation facility located southeast of Point Judith, Rhode Island, southeast of Connecticut, and southwest of Martha's Vineyard, MA qualifies as a Class I renewable energy source.

B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

By Application received April 13, 2026 (Application), Revolution Wind, LLC (Company) requests that the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (Authority) determine that the wind generation facility (Facility or Project) qualifies as a Class I renewable energy source.

C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING

There is no statutory requirement for a hearing, no person requested a hearing, and none was held.

D. PARTICIPANTS

The Authority recognized the following as Participants to this proceeding: Revolution Wind, LLC, 56 Exchange Terrace, Suite 300, Providence, RI 02903; the Office of Consumer Counsel, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, CT 06051; and the Commissioner of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, 79 Elm Street, Hartford, CT 06106.

II. STANDARD REVIEW

Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-1(a)(20), "Class I renewable energy source" includes energy derived from wind power.

III. AUTHORITY ANALYSIS

As provided in the Application, the Facility generates electricity using wind power. The Project began commercial operation on March 13, 2026, and has an installed capacity of 715 MW. The Facility's NEPOOL GIS Identification Number is MSS75124. The Project is a grid-connected generation facility located in Connecticut, Massachusetts and Rhode Island, and meets the requirements for monitoring and verification of its electricity produced.

IV. CONCLUSION

The Authority reviewed all information in the record and finds that pursuant to General Statutes § 16-1(a)(20), the Facility qualifies as a Class I renewable energy source, effective March 13, 2026. The Authority assigns the Facility Connecticut Renewable Portfolio Standard Registration No. CT260417.

The Authority's determination in this docket is based on the information submitted by the Company. The Authority may reverse its ruling or revoke the Company's registration if any material information provided proves to be false or misleading. The Company is reminded that it is obligated to notify the Authority within 10 days of any changes to any of the information it has provided.
