To the Board:

On behalf of the North Kingstown Department of Public Works, I am writing this advisory opinion for the proposed Revolution Wind offshore wind electrical generation project, as directed by Preliminary Order. The order requests whether any town permits are required, what may be the impact on traffic and road conditions associated with the construction and operation of the facilities on town roads. The town road impacted is Camp Avenue. A permit is required.

The Department requires that any excavation in the town right-of-way obtain an excavation permit, per the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17-46 Article III. The potential impact on traffic and road conditions would be temporary, mitigated by police details and signage to manage traffic. The stipulations would be specified in the permit. The impact of the long-term operation of the utility in the right-of-way would be negligible since it is underground.

The Department of Public Works does not foresee any issues with this project.
