**MOTION FOR INTERVENTION
OF THE TOWN OF NORTH KINGSTOWN**

Pursuant to Rule 1.10 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Energy Facility Siting Board (the "EFSB"), the Town of North Kingstown, a duly organized municipal corporation of the State of Rhode Island (the "Town"), files this Motion For Intervention requesting leave to intervene as a party in the above proceedings stating in support thereof the following:

1. Revolution Wind, LLC "Revolution") proposes to site and construct the transmission and infrastructure necessary to deliver energy onshore from its offshore wind farm located in federal waters.
2. The onshore transmission cable and certain onshore transmission components are proposed to be constructed in, on, or under streets and real property owned by the Town. This infrastructure construction will result in disruption to the streets in question; disruption to a local beach; and perhaps concerns of the residents of the Town.
3. The interests of the Town are directly affected by this proceeding, are not adequately represented by the existing parties, and the action of EFSB may be binding on the Town.

WHEREFORE, the Town of North Kingstown requests to be granted leave to intervene in this proceeding as a full party.
