NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 42-98 and 42-35 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island as amended, in particular, sections 42-98-7; 42-98-9; 42-98-9.1, and sections 1.6(f); 1.6(g); 1.6(h); and 1.2(d) of its Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), **the Energy Facility Siting Board (Board) will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at 5:00 pm at the Department of Environmental Management Foundry Offices, Room 300, 235 Promenade Street, Providence, Rhode Island.** Public comment will be heard. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and from time to time as required.

In its application, the Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid seeks the approval of the Energy Facility Siting Board to relocate the portion of the existing Q-143 and R-144 115 kV transmission lines (the "Q-143 and R-144 Lines") between the Franklin Square Substation and the vicinity of manhole no. 31 on Dollar Street in Providence, Rhode Island (the "Project"). The new route is approximately 1,930 feet long. Section 1.6(f) of the Rules provides for an abbreviated review in cases involving the modification or relocation of existing power lines.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Board may issue a determination as to whether the proposed project "may result in a significant impact on the environment or the public health, safety and welfare" thereby requiring a full Board review. If the Board determines that the project will not result in a significant impact on the environment or the public health, safety and welfare, then the project is determined not to constitute an alteration and may proceed without further review. The application is on file and available for public review at the offices of the Board at the Public Utilities Commission, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island, and online at www.ripuc.org/efsb.

Room 300 of the Department of Environmental Management Foundry Offices is accessible to the handicapped.
