**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 39-1-1 and 39-3-11 of the General Laws, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, December 4, 2007 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the Public Utilities Commission, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

In this docket, the Commission will examine the propriety of a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) jointly submitted and entered by and between National Grid (“Company”), the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, The Energy Council of Rhode Island and Environment Northeast seeking approval of the Company’s 2008 Demand Side Management (“DSM”) Programs and services with an overall budget of approximately of \$21,000,000. The proposed budget includes a mandatory charge of \$0.0020 per kWh (legislatively mandated by the Rhode Island Utility Restructuring Act) for application in the billings months of January through December 2008. The proposed budget is to fund and implement energy efficiency programs targeted at different classes of residential, commercial and industrial customers.

The deadline to file a Motion to Intervene as a party in this docket is November 16, 2007. The Stipulation and Settlement may be examined at the Commission’s office and at the office of National Grid, 280 Melrose Street, Providence, Rhode Island. The filing can also be accessed under the Commission’s Docket Menu at [www.ripuc.org](http://www.ripuc.org).

Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws; specifically Sections 39-1-7, 39-1-8, 39-1-11, 39-1-12, 39-1-18, 39-1-20, 42-35-8 and 42-35-10.
