With this filing, Verizon Rhode Island ("Verizon RI") proposes rate increases to the surcharges applied to the following operator-dialed calls:

	Current Rate	Proposed Rate
Operator-Dialed – Station to Station	\$2.50	\$3.75
Operator-Dialed – Collect and Bill to a Third Number	\$2.50	\$3.75
Operator-Dialed – Coin-Paid Station-to-Station	\$0.69	\$3.75

These surcharges are applied to calls for which the customer requests that the operator dial the call. These increases have no effect on customers who, as a result of a physical limitation, are

unable to dial a call. Those customers will continue to be afforded the customer-dialed rate for their calls requiring operator assistance. Additionally, these surcharges are not applied to calls for which the customer reports a trouble condition and requires the assistance of an operator when attempting to complete a call.

This filing also proposes an increase to the rate charged for a Busy Line Verification from \$2.50 to \$3.75. Busy Line Verification involves an operator determining the status of an exchange line at the request of a customer. This charge does not apply when the verification indicates a trouble status on the line.
