I am writing in response to the Commission's Notice of June 24, 2010 requesting the parties to Docket 4111 to inform the Commission of their intent to participate as a party in this proceeding.

The Rhode Island Economic Development Corporation ("RIEDC"), a party to Docket 4111, hereby gives notice, through counsel, that it intends to intervene in this proceeding, as authorized by the terms of R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.1-7(b). Specifically, RIEDC intends to sponsor the testimony of an expert witness "experienced in power markets, renewable energy project financing, and power contracts," to assist the Commission in its review of the amended Power Purchase Agreement filed on June 20, 2010, as required by R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.1-7(b). The RIEDC intends to file this testimony, in accordance with the statutory time frame, and scheduling order, unless that date is otherwise modified by Order of the Commission.

In addition, R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.1-7(c)(iii) and (iv) further requires the RIEDC to file an "Advisory Opinion" with the Commission that assesses whether "the amended agreement is likely to provide economic development benefits, including: facilitating new and existing business expansion and the creation of new renewable energy jobs; the further development of Quonset Business Park; and, increasing the training and preparedness of the Rhode Island workforce to support renewable energy projects." This is to inform the Commission that the RIEDC also intends to file its Advisory Opinion in accordance with the statutory time frame and scheduling order, unless that date is otherwise modified by Order of the Commission.
