

**RESPONSES OF CINTEX WIRELESS, LLC
TO THE COMMISSION’S FIRST SET OF DATA REQUESTS**

Cintex Wireless, LLC (“Cintex”), by its undersigned counsel, hereby responds to the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission’s First Set of Data Requests as set forth below.

REQUEST 1-1: On page 5 of Cintex’s Petition, Cintex states: “Cintex will charge a customary charge for commencing telecommunications service of \$70.00. Cintex will recover \$30.00 of this activation fee through disbursements from USAC. Consistent with FCC Rule 54.411(a)(2), the balance will be recovered from subscribers via a deferred payment schedule of twelve months.” Given the fact that this is a pre-paid service without a service contract, please explain the mechanism through which Cintex will recover the remaining \$40.00 of the activation fee from customers.

RESPONSE 1-1: Cintex proposes to waive the remaining \$40 activation fee for Rhode Island Lifeline consumers.

REQUEST 1-2: Please provide copies of Cintex’s proposed marketing material.

RESPONSE 1-2: Examples of Cintex’s marketing material is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

REQUEST 1-3: Please provide a listing of other jurisdictions in which Cintex has been granted ETC status.

RESPONSE 1-3: Cintex has not yet been granted ETC status in any state. Cintex has petitions pending in Rhode Island, New Jersey, Louisiana, West Virginia, Maine and Arkansas.


REQUEST 1-4: If Cintex is an ETC in other jurisdictions, has Cintex experienced any problems in any jurisdictions in which it has received ETC certification regarding customer “gaming” or “double dipping” in Lifeline programs between wireline and wireless service despite the self-certification under penalties of perjury that were accepted by the FCC?

RESPONSE 1-5: Cintex has not yet been designated an ETC in any state. However, the Commission’s requirement that ETC’s collect documentation that supports customer eligibility should significantly reduce abuse.

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
