





**MOTION TO INTERVENE**


Now comes the City of Warwick (the "City"), by and through its City Solicitor, and hereby moves to intervene in the above-captioned matter. As grounds, the City avers that it has a particular and substantial interest which will be directly affected and which is not represented by any existing party in this proceeding. The issue concerns the Providence Water Supply Board's (the "Board") request to seek a purchase water sale rate hike of more than 32 percent to collect additional revenues. The City purchases most of its potable water from the Board and provides that purchased water to its customers. In addition, the City purchases water from the Kent County Water Authority (the "Authority") for several thousand customers located within the City. These customers are primarily located in the Cowesett, Apponaug and Tollgate areas of the City. The City anticipates that the Authority will pass through any rate increase approved for the Board since the Authority also purchases some of its potable water from the Board. Warwick therefore anticipates that all of its customers will have to bear any increase in the rate for water purchased from the Board. The attached Exhibit 1 provides an illustrative example of a purchase water rate hike of more than 32 percent, as requested by the Board, and the impact on purchase water costs by customers using different quantities of water.

Based on this situation the City requests intervention status to examine the need and justification for the sought after rate hike by the Board. Without granting the City's Motion to Intervene, the City's water customers will not be represented by an existing party to this

proceeding. (R.I. Gen. Laws 45-6-1 (1999 & Supp. 2008)(Rule 1.13 Rules of Practice and Procedure). The City has a direct interest in the affect an approval of this rate hike Petition would have on its customers located within the City.

For these reasons and pursuant to PUC Rule 1.13, the City hereby requests the PUC to grant its Motion to Intervene.
