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CHAMPLAIN WIND, LLC’S MOTION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES Champlain Wind, LLC (“Champlain Wind”), and pursuant to Rule 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure for the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), moves that the Commission grant Champlain Wind the right to intervene as a party in the above-captioned docket for the reasons set forth herein:

1. Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (“National Grid”) is authorized under RIGL §39-26.1-1, et. seq., (the “Long-Term Contracting Standard For Renewable Energy” or the “Act”) to enter into long term contracts for the purchase of energy, capacity and renewable energy certificates from renewable generators meeting the requirements of the Act.

2. Champlain Wind, LLC is a Delaware limited liability company that is developing the Bowers Wind Project located in Carroll Plantation and Kossuth Township, Maine.

3. The Bowers Wind Project qualifies as a Newly Developed Renewable Energy Resource as defined by RIGL §39-26.1-2(6).

4. On September 3, 2013, National Grid submitted a Power Purchase Agreement with Champlain Wind for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to the Long-Term Contracting Standard For Renewable Energy.

5. Champlain Wind has a significant interest that may be directly affected by the Commission's review and decision in this matter. This interest is not adequately represented or protected by the existing parties in this docket, and Champlain Wind may be bound by the Commission's action in this docket.

6. In addition, it is in the public interest that both parties to the proposed Power Purchase Agreement – National Grid and Champlain Wind – participate in this proceeding to answer any and all questions raised by the Commission or any other parties in this docket.

WHEREFORE, Champlain Wind, LLC requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Intervene and that it be granted status as a party in this proceeding.
