KENT COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY'S MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF BRISTOL COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM ORDER

Now comes the Kent County Water Authority ("KCWA") and hereby supports the Bristol Water Authority's ("BCWA") Motion for Relief from Order in the within Docket.

Specifically, KCWA supports and agrees with the cogent analysis BCWA set forth in its Motion for Relief from the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") February 10, 2017, Order in regard to the allocations costs for the Central Operations Facility ("COF") to wholesale customers. KCWA asserts that the Providence Water Supply Board ("PWSB") failed to provide any evidence to support a rationale for the allocation costs of the CFO to wholesale customers.

In Docket #4571, the Parties agreed that the allocation of costs for the COF would be based on the functional use to each rate class. Although, in Docket 4618, PWSB submitted evidence of the COF costs allocated to wholesale customers would be 21.50 % of the overall costs, it failed to submit any evidence, including the functionality methodology as agreed in Docket # 4571, for the rationale for those costs. As a result, PWSB failed to satisfy its burden that the annual 21.50% COF cost allocation to wholesale customers is necessary to obtain

reasonable compensation for the services rendered. See: RI Gen. Laws Section 39-3-12.

Because PWSB failed to meet its burden, under Rule 1.28 (b)(6) of the Commission's Rules of Practice & Procedure,³ relief from the Commission's February 10, 2017 order is justified. For these reasons and the reasons presented in BCWA's Motion, KCWA supports BCWA's Motion and respectfully requests this Commission grant the BCWA's Motion for Relief of Order as petitioned.
