Electric Infrastructure, Safety, and Reliability Plan FY 2018, Docket 4682

The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (“Narragansett” or “the Company”) submitted its Fiscal Year 2018 Infrastructure, Safety, and Reliability (ISR) Plan on December 21, 2016. Calculations supporting the revenue requirements associated with the vegetation management, inspection and maintenance, and qualifying capital investment components are included in the Electric ISR Plan.

At the request of the Division, I have reviewed the filing for the purpose of verifying the accuracy of the filed revenue requirements associated with the FY 2018 activity under the ISR programs.

Based on my review, I believe the revenue requirement associated with the filed FY 2018 Electric ISR Plan is reasonably calculated, for effect April 1, 2017, subject to the future reconciliation of the FY 2018 Plan revenue requirement.
